PLAT OF MARLBOROUGH.

Subdivision of a part of Sections 14 and 13, Town 17 North Range 13 West, Twp of Pleasant Plains, County of Lake, State of Michigan. Sheet No. 1. See Sheets No. 2 and 3.

Surveyed and platted by Frederick Tibbals, Surveyor, FERN PORTLAND CEMENT COMPANY and is to be known as Marlborough.

I hereby certify that the plat herein and on the other sheets numbered 1 and 3 of Marlborough are correct and that permanent monuments consisting of 4 inch iron pipes have been placed at points marked, thirteen chain intervals and street and alley intersections.

The land embraced in this plat is owned by the GREAT NORTHERN PORTLAND CEMENT COMPANY and is to be known as Marlborough and shown on this plat consisting of three sheets numbered 1, 2 and 3 as described in the following: The entire north one half of Section fourteen, the Northwest quarter of Section fifteen and the East half of Section sixteen of township 17 North Range 13 West.

KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that The Great Northern Portland Cement Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of New Jersey, and having an office and place of business at Detroit, in the County of Wayne and State of Michigan, as proprietor of the above described lands, has caused the same to be surveyed, laid out, and platted, to be known as Marlborough, and that the streets, alleys, boulevards and public places shown on said plat are hereby dedicated to the use of the public, as shown and ascertained in presence of a Just and True Assessor.

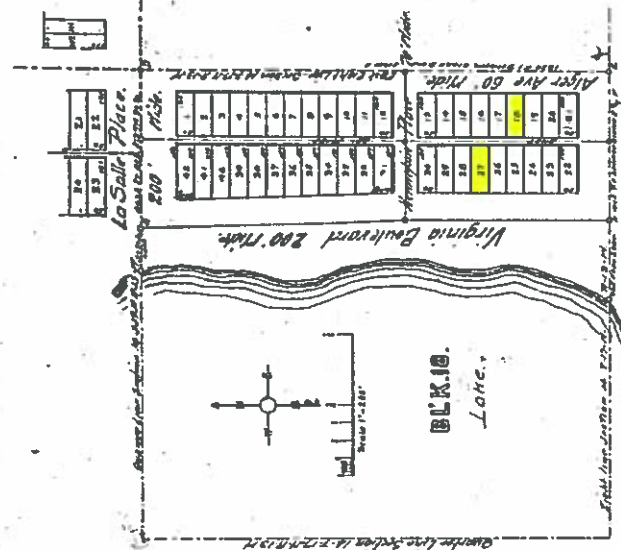
